WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small text files that websites visited by users send to their terminals or devices, where they are stored to be re-transmitted to the same websites during subsequent visits. Cookies can be set directly by the website owner (**first-party cookies**) or be set by a website other than the one the user is visiting (**third-party cookies**).

Cookies are used for various purposes: a distinction is made between "**technical**" **cookies**, which are necessary to carry out navigation or provide a service requested by the user – and not used for further purposes – and "**profiling**" **cookies**, which are used to track the user's navigation on the network and create profiles based on tastes, habits, choices, etc.

On the website <http://inclusivesport.eu/> only **technical cookies** are installed. These are necessary to allow navigation within the site and its correct functioning. **There are no first-party profiling cookies.**

WHAT COOKIES ARE PRESENT ON THE SITE?

This site uses cookies to perform activities strictly necessary for its operation, for example, in relation to traffic distribution; this site uses cookies to optimize the user's browsing experience.

CONSENT (OPT-IN) TO THE USE OF COOKIES

All **technical cookies** do **not require consent**, and are therefore installed automatically following access to the site or service.

Consent to the use of cookies, including those of third parties, is provided by the user through the following methods:

Closing the banner, by clicking the "ok" button present in the banner itself; or

Accessing another area of the Site or clicking on any element of the page (image or link) outside the banner.

The user can act on the browser settings at any time to block the profiling activity carried out through cookies.

This site does not use non-technical cookies.

HOW TO REVOKE (OPT-OUT) CONSENT TO THE USE OF COOKIES?

With reference to Cookies installed by third parties, the user can manage their settings and revoke consent using the tools described in the third party's privacy policy or by contacting them directly.

Cookies can be completely deactivated from the **browser** using the appropriate function provided in most browsing programs.

- **INTERNET EXPLORER**

Change Cookie settings: Click on the "Tools" icon, "Internet Options," then the "Privacy" tab. You can adjust the cookie acceptance policy by moving the related slider up or down or by clicking the "Sites" button and in the window that appears, authorize or block the acceptance of cookies site by site. Click "OK" to apply the changes.

Delete Cookies: Select "Tools," "Internet Options," then "Delete" from the "Browsing History" panel. You will find a series of items including Cookies. Verify that the check mark corresponding to its name is activated and press "Delete."

- **GOOGLE CHROME**

Change Cookie settings: Type `chrome://settings/` in the address bar, then select "Show advanced settings" at the bottom of the page and, subsequently, "Content settings" in the "Privacy and security" section, and then "Allow local data to be set (recommended)," then "Done."

Delete Cookies: Type `chrome://history/` in the address bar and then select "Clear browsing data..." You will find a series of items including "Cookies and other site and plug-in data." Verify that the check mark corresponding to its name is activated and press "Clear browsing data."

- **MOZILLA FIREFOX**

Change Cookie settings: Access options via the menu icon, then select the "Privacy & Security" section. Under the History entry, choose: "Use custom settings for

history," then adjust cookie management through the options made available by the program. Click "OK" to apply the changes.

Delete Cookies: Access options via the menu icon, then select the "Privacy & Security" section. Under the History entry, choose: "Use custom settings for history," then click on the "Show Cookies" button. The Cookies window will appear: In the "Search" field, type the name of the site for which you want to remove cookies. A list showing the cookies related to the search performed will appear. In the list, select the cookies to remove and click on the "Remove Selected" button. To delete all cookies stored on your computer, you can use the "Remove All Cookies" button.

- **SAFARI**

Change Cookie settings: Click on "Preferences" from the "Tools" menu (key combination CTRL+) then select the "Privacy" section. Choose the cookie management policy by selecting one of the options offered by the program, then close the options window from the closing icon at the top right.

Delete Cookies: Click on "Preferences" from the "Tools" menu (key combination CTRL+) then select the "Privacy" section. Click on "Manage Website Data" and then confirm the choice. Choose the cookie management policy by selecting one of the options offered by the program and then close the options window from the closing icon at the top right.
